

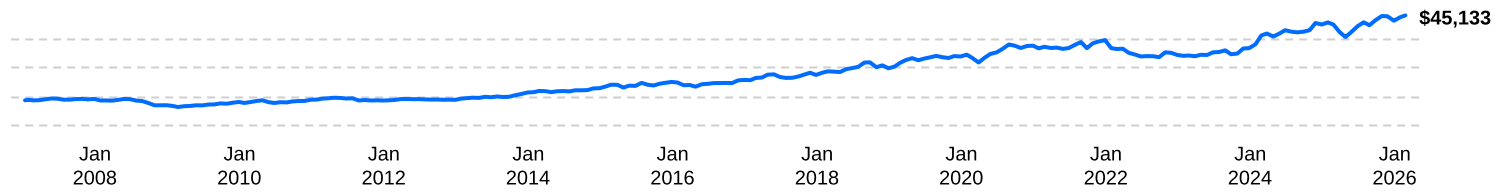

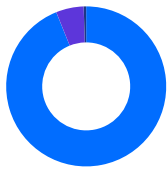
Why invest in Dynamic American Fund ?

Growth of \$10,000

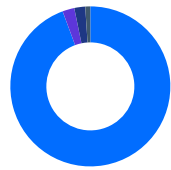


Asset Allocation (%)



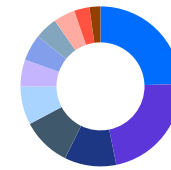
