

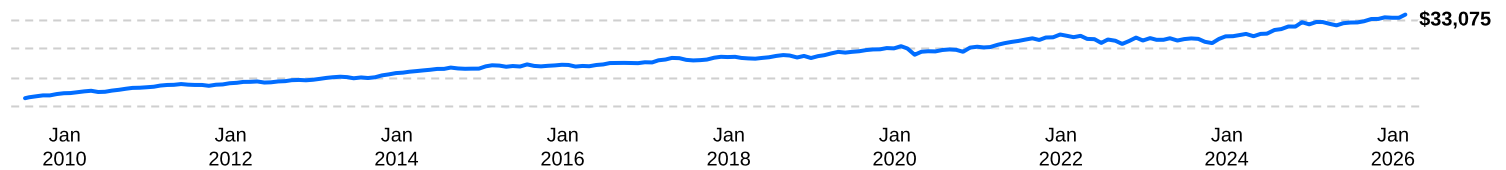

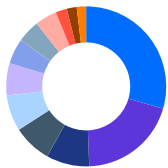
Why invest in Dynamic Strategic Yield Class ?

Growth of \$10,000

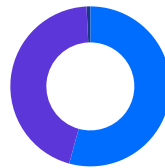


Asset Allocation (%)¹



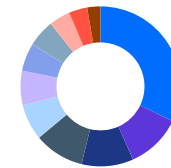
