

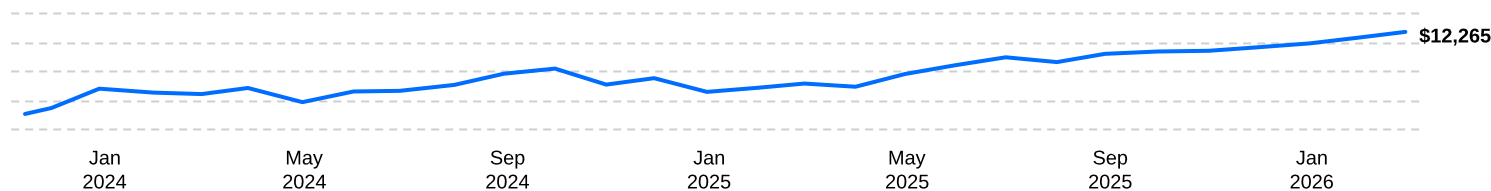

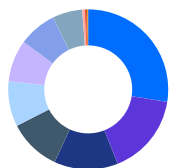

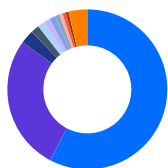


Asset Allocation (%)



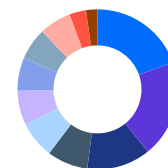
