

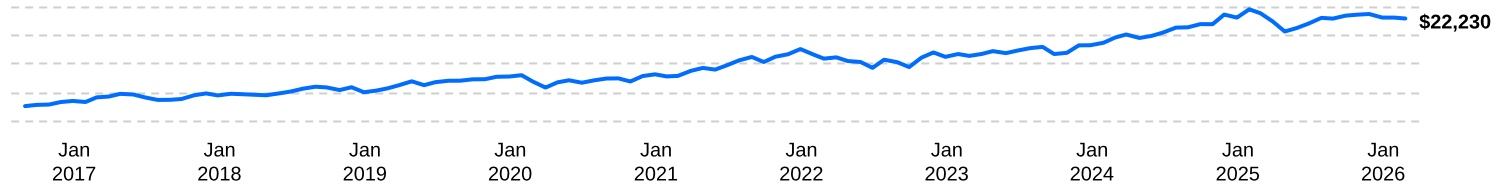

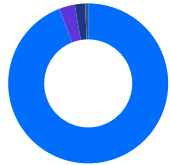
Why invest in Dynamic U.S. Equity Income Fund ?

Growth of \$10,000

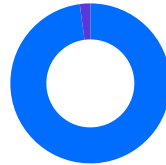


Asset Allocation (%)



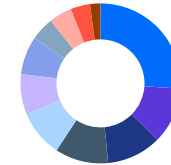
